## **APPLICATION:**

#### **Primer Coat**

Spot prime bare and repaired areas with Professional Gypsum and Plaster Primer (PP 700). Allow 16 hours to dry.
Finishing Coats

Apply two full coats of Professional Contractors Matt (PEM 600/TCP) to achieve complete obliteration, allowing 1 hour drying between coats.

- ^ Technical Data Sheet (TDS): User must always ensure that latest issue is used.
- A B = Brush (ready for use), R = Roller (synthetic, min. 10mm pile) (ready for use), S = Airless spray (ready for use).
