SURFACE PREPARATION:

- Ensure that surfaces are clean, dry and sound.
- ^ Remove dirt and loose particles.
- (EXCLUDING GYPSUM BOARD): Remove any oil, grease and other contaminants with Plascon Aquasolv Degreaser (GR 1) working it well into affected areas with bristle broom or brush. Leave for 20 minutes to react, rinse thoroughly with fresh water to remove all traces of Plascon Aquasolv Degreaser (GR 1). Allow to dry completely. Sand smooth and dust off.
- A GYPSUM BOARD: Remove any oil, grease and surface contaminates using a mutton cloth in-conjunction with Plascon Mineral Turps (AZH 1).
- ^ Fill holes, gaps and other surface defects with Polycell Polyfilla Interior (101002). Allow 4 hours to dry. Sand smooth. Dust off. Spot prime filled areas with Plaster Primer. Allow 16 hours to dry.

APPLICATION:

Primer Coat

Apply one coat of Plascon Plaster Primer (UC 56) to achieve a continuous film. Allow 16 hours to dry.

Finishing Coats

^ Apply two full coats of Plascon Double Velvet (VEL/TDV) to achieve complete obliteration, allowing 2 hours drying between coats.

TABLE REFERENCES:

- Technical Data Sheet (TDS): User must always ensure that latest issue is used.
- B = Brush (ready for use), R = Roller (synthetic, min. 10mm pile) (ready for use), S = Airless spray (ready for use).
- ^ Theoretical spreading rate quoted is for smooth non-porous substrates and does not include allowance for surface profile, porosity, wastage and uneven film application.
