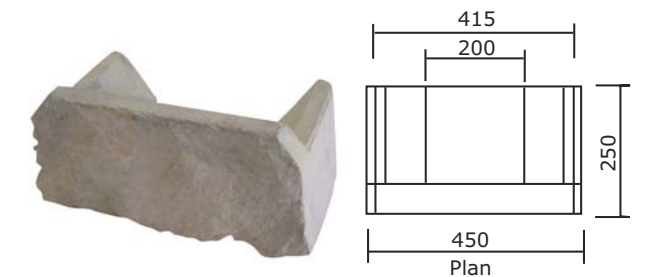
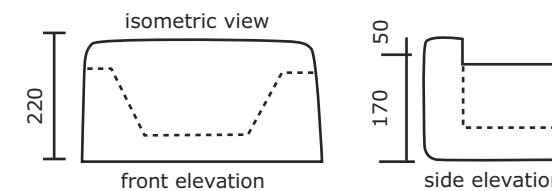
- Speed - construction speed and immediate utilization.
- Cost - low labour cost for construction.
- Flexibility - accommodate ground movement.
- Aesthetics - can be constructed with curves, planted with vegetation and looks like natural stone.

### Design and construction:

The blocks (weight 28kg) are placed on a gravel/concrete foundation.

### Successive courses are stacked after compaction of the sand filled in behind the blocks. Internal soil pressure and overturning is resisted by:

- Shear forces between courses
- Mechanical interlocking
- Weight of units
- Weight of infill behind blocks



### Where any uncertainty exists due to:

- Soft or loose soil
- Ground water
- Excessive height

A professional engineer should be consulted.
